


Administrative Order on Automatic Continuances to Care for a New Child


The Probate Courts recognize the importance of expectant and new parents to be able to petition the Courts for an automatic continuance of trial settings in order to prepare for and care for a new child.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a lead counsel designated pursuant to Tex. R. Civ. P. 8 who has been actively engaged in a proceeding in a Harris County Probate Court may seek an automatic continuance of a trial setting for up to 120 days to care for a new child, whether for the birth, the adoption, or placement of a child in foster care. Such motion may be set and considered by submission.


